Safe Area

For visual impact, please allow a clear area around the logo. This area is know as the "exclusion zone" and is defined by the height of the racquet.

Minimum Size

To ensure legibility, the minimum width of the logo, should never be less than .75 inches (print) or 54 pixels (screen).
